Grant Program Overview

Center for the Study of Multicultural Children's Literature (CSMCL) is an organization advocating for multicultural children's literature which includes librarians, teachers, parents, caregivers, students, and experts in the field of children's literature. CSMCL will award a \$500.00 grant in selected multicultural children's books to your library that serve children and their families who are having a Día library program, El Día de Los Niños/El Día de Los Libros (Children's Day/Book Day) with an African American Focus. The Día grant is funded by the CSMCL in partnership with the Association of Library Services to Children (ALSC) and author Pat Mora, the founder of Children's Day, Book Day/ El día de los niños, El día de los libros; often known as Día.

Grant Eligibility

Libraries that serve children and their families who are having a Día program, El Día de Los Niños/El Día de Los Libros (Children's Day/Book Day), with an African American Focus are eligible to apply. The Día event must be held on or about **April 30, 2016**.

Grant Award Amount

CSMCL will award a \$500 grant in selected multicultural children's books for your library. To verify the event, the winning library must submit 15 digital photos (as jpegs) of the Día event to CSMCL by sending the 15 jpegs on a USB flash drive via email or U.S. Mail no later than one week after the Día event.

Selection Criteria

Awardees will be selected based upon creativity and originality of the implementation of their 2016 Día program, El Día de Los Niños/El Día de Los Libros (Children's Day/Book Day), with an African American Focus.
