Two spring books from a new writing duo: Pat Mora and her daughter, Libby Martinez


Annapolis, MD - This April, mother-and-daughter writing partners Pat Mora and Libby Martinez will see their first two collaborative children's books published.

A tiny mouse, Chico Canta, saves his entire family from the clever kitten, Little Gato-Gato, when he uses his quick wits and ability to speak another language.
